This conference will be different!

Due to the COVID-19 social distance and travel restrictions enforced worldwide, the conference will be held as planned but this time in an innovative and adjusted online format.

How the conference will unfold

Keynotes

Keynotes addresses are pre-recorded (up to 40m long) and LEADING will upload them to the conference platform. They can be watched at the scheduled time slot. The chair will first introduce the keynote speaker and, after the presentation, will moderate a 20m **live discussion session** between the keynote speaker and the audience. Participants may use the platform chat mode feature for interactions.

Symposia

Symposium papers are pre-recorded (10m each) and LEADING will upload them to the conference platform. Every symposium session will begin with the viewing of the pre-recorded papers' presentations (10m each), made available to the audience from this moment on. To prevent technical issues and for the session to run smoothly, the organizer/chair will only enter live after all pre-recorded papers have been shown. At this time, he/she may welcome the authors and introduce the discussion. The discussant will have 10m for comments and integration. Then the chair will moderate a 20m live discussion session between the Authors, the discussant, and the audience. Participants may use the chat mode feature in the platform for interactions. During the time slot, Authors should be online and engage live in the discussion. The moderator will receive the audience questions and direct them to the assigned author.

Thematic Sessions - Individual Papers

Individual papers are pre-recorded and LEADING will upload them to the conference platform. Papers are grouped into thematic sessions and made available from the conference day 1. On the scheduled time slot, authors should be available online to engage in a 20 min **live discussion** with the audience. All thematic sessions will have a moderator who will receive the audience questions by chat and direct them to the assigned author. Participants interested in these sessions are encouraged to preview the presentations' videos before the scheduled session.

Roundtables & Meet-the-Editors Session

Roundtables and Meet-the-Editors Session will occur **live**. Roundtables will gather 3/4 researchers who will discuss a common theme/issue. All participants are invited to engage in the discussion by posing their questions to the researcher. The moderator will be responsible for selecting and directing the questions to the respective researcher. During the session the audience might be invited to participate through the live polling feature.

Posters

LEADING will upload all posters to the conference platform and make them available from the conference's day 1. Posters are grouped into thematic sessions and scheduled in a specific time slot. Authors are expected to be online and available in chat mode to respond and interact with the audience, especially during the assigned time slot.

EARA2020 online conference participants will have the opportunity to access to all presentations **up to 2 weeks** after the end of the conference.

General features of the conference platform

Agenda

The program structure will appear organized by day and by virtual room within each day, in order to make it as easy as possible for participants to choose which session they would like to attend. Participants can in advance of the conference start, mark their favorite sessions and build their own agenda; planning which sessions they wish to attend. They will also receive reminders before each marked sessions.

Q&A with moderation

Due to the number of participants, we will use a Q&A with moderation feature for interactions with audience in live sessions. This feature allows for participants to pose questions during the sessions, while the moderator filters and picks the ones that will go live in a user-friendly restricted back office.

Live polling

A live polling feature will be available in order to keep a high level of engagement and to measure the audience's response to the sessions. This feature will transform one-sided presentations into two-way conversations with the audience. This web-based audience response system lets the presenters embed interactive activities directly into their presentation. The audience responds on the web or using a smartphone.

Conference platform

LEADING will be launching the platform 7 days before the conference so that participants have time prior to the conference to be acquainted with the format.

The conference platform is hosted at the AWS Cloud. The AWS provides data centers and a network architected to protect your information, identities, applications, and devices.

This conference will be different! But together we hope to reach a nice destination!
